

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Walking Tour. Our map covers what most people can do in an hour or two on foot: the oldest and most central parts of Ebensburg. In this area, map numbers help you connect the locations to the text. Sites and structures are listed in **bold type**. In many instances standard markers (See sample on address panel of this guide) of the *Association for Historic Ebensburg* are in place: look for them!

Extended Tour. Since most visitors will have cars and wish to see places lying off the map, we have included many such (with addresses) both in the main text and in a special section: **Around the Town**. Don't overlook these if you want a better picture of our town!

More Information. You will be able to purchase an illustrated booklet, *EBENSBURG, Mountain Spa and Wilderness Crossroads: Its Historic Sites*, at regular visitor information centers. 

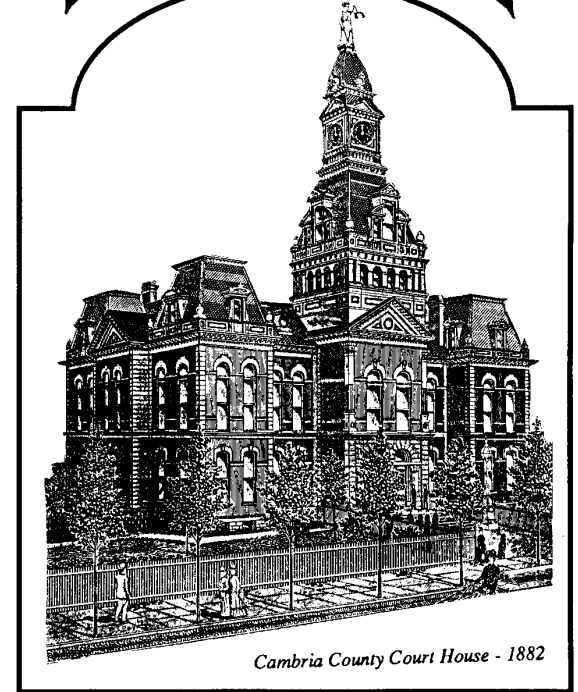
