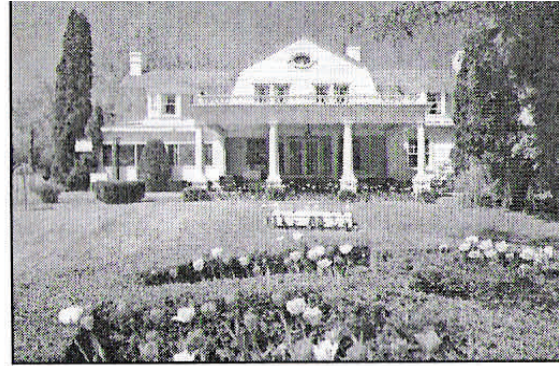

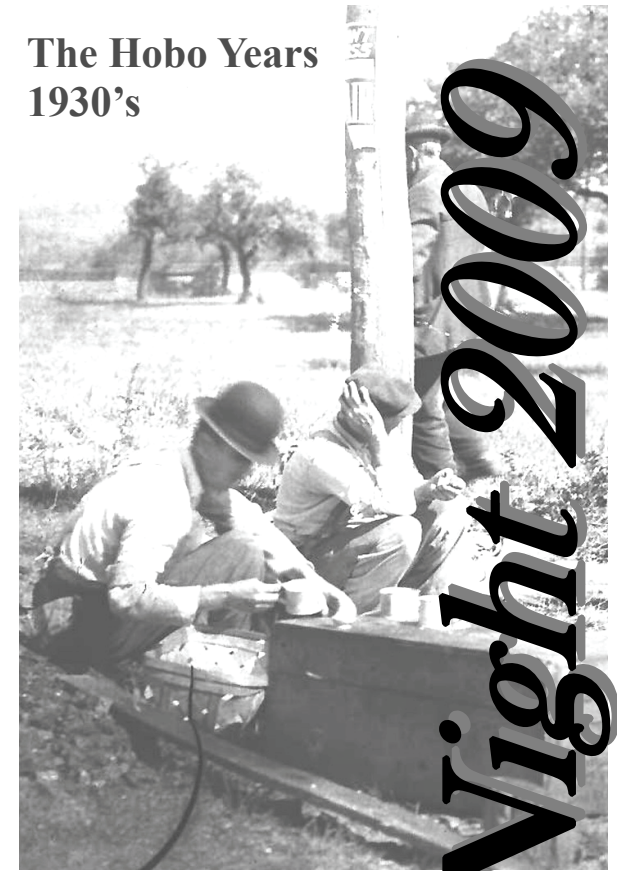

General Information

The Spirit Night walking tour is approximately one hour in length, during which participants will be either walking or standing. Please wear comfortable shoes and weather appropriate clothing. You may want to use a flashlight for uneven footing. Let us know if you have special needs.

Tours

Tours will depart from the Cambria County Courthouse on South Center Street, through downtown, along West Sample, North Cherry Alley eventually ending up at the Cambria County Historical Society. Transportation will be available to take you back to the parking lot of the courthouse if you so wish.

Rain Date

All tours will depart "rain or shine." If the weather is threatening, rain gear and an umbrella may be advisable.

Reservations

We will try to make your reservations by your 1st, 2nd and 3rd choice. It is important that we are able to reach you by phone to confirm or adjust your reservations. You should have a reservation for this event. Walk-ins from 8:30 PM to 9:00 PM ONLY.

Tours depart from the courthouse every 10 minutes. Please arrive a few minutes early.
