Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

1. Most Victorian
2. Most Creative
3. Most Artistic
4. Most representative of Cambria County History
5. Best of Show

Not all entries need to represent county history. Other entries will be judged in their own categories. There is no need to enter under a particular category.

Rules:

1. Open to anyone age 18 and under.
 2. Adult entries are permitted but will not be judged or win a prize.
 3. Entries do not necessarily need to represent a “house”.
 4. All parts of the entry, except for the base, must be edible.
 5. The base must not exceed 24”x24”. *Entries are not judged on size.*
 6. There must be no identifying name on the entry. i.e. “Girl Scout Troop 120- Jackson Twp”, “The John Jones Family”, “Mrs. Smith’s Sixth Grade Class”.
 7. Names such as “Middle School” or “Boy Scouts” are acceptable.
 8. Entries that are disqualified by these rules will still be allowed to be displayed.
 9. Entries must be dropped off at the Cambria County Historical Society at 615 N. Center Street, Ebensburg, PA (814-472-6674) between Tuesday November 30 and Thursday December 2. Museum Hours are 10AM to 4PM. No entries will be accepted on Friday.
