Reference Services

Professional librarians provide reference assistance to patrons in the library and quick reference assistance over the phone and via email. Reference librarians and other staff help patrons within the library by offering basic instruction in the use of the library's automated catalog and reader advisory services. The reference staff can provide limited assistance with various computer programs.

The reference staff also offers an Hour with the Librarian service allows you to spend up to one hour with a professional librarian or another qualified staff member who can offer personalized assistance.

Assistance is also given to individuals who wish to print from personal devices such as laptops and cell phones. The professional librarians can proctor exams free of charge and the staff can send faxes for a fee of \$2.00 plus .12 tax for every 5 pages sent.

The library maintains a special circulating collection of test tutor books and car repair manuals, a collection of non-cataloged paperback classics, a vertical file of special interest materials, and government documents acquired through its status as a Depository library which are housed in the reference area. Hard copies of back issues of current local newspapers and a variety of periodicals are stored in the Periodical Department which is adjacent to the reference area.
